PAVE AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

DANCE

Prepare a one minute choreographed piece of your own choice. You are responsible for your own music. Your music should be on an iPod, smartphone or CD. A playback system will be available at the audition. Performers should wear appropriate attire (leotards, tights, dance shoes are highly recommended. No baggy pants or oversized tee shirts).

VISUAL ARTS

Bring at least three finished art works from your portfolio. If one or more of these are large sculptures, photographs of the work(s) are acceptable. If your specialty is photography,

8" x 10" prints of your photographs may be included in the three works. These works will stay with you and will not be held. You will be required to do 2 drawings at the audition:

1. An observational drawing (a still-life) which will be set up. 2. An imaginative drawing from your personal memory. Drawing materials will be provided.

MUSIC

Prepare to perform a 2 minute musical solo/excerpt of your own choice. Depending on the number of applicants, you may be cut short. Bring your own music with you to the audition. Be prepared to:

- 1. Bring your own music (original copies) with you to the audition.
 - a. Vocalists
 - i. An accompanist will be provided for vocalists.
 - ii. Vocalists should memorize their music.
 - b. Instrumentalists
 - i. Perform 7 major scales.
 - ii. Play a minimal Grade 3 level NYSSMA non- jazz solo.
 - iii. Instrumentalists should select music from a classical style.
- 2. Sight read/sing (vocalists may use Solfege, neutral vowels or numbers).
- 3. Repeat verbatim exercises that are either played or sung using neutral vowels.
- 4. Tap rhythmic exercises verbatim that are demonstrated for you.

ACTING

Perform with enthusiasm a one minute memorized scene from a choice of several provided scenes. Choose your role from the scene provided. Work on your voice and meaningful movement. You will also be asked to improvise a scene given to you. Be prepared to stay for the duration of the audition period. Come comfortably dressed and be prepared to explain why you wish to perform, what you hope to learn, and what you will contribute to the PAVE program.

*** <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Students must maintain an average of <u>80</u> or above in the PAVE program and register for the required companion course to remain enrolled in the course. ***
